

Proof of English Knowledge

Exemptions

According to the Greek government and the P.D. 146/2007 ar. 1 you can be exempted from submitting a certificate from the lists if you submit a:

 (i) Certification of the relative Ministry or Embassy of the respective country in Greece (in case that there is no organization) that the submitted certificate is accepted in the country's public services as well as the private sector as a valid proof of English knowledge.

You can also be exempted from having a certificate if you provide a stamped declaration/certificate written on official paper, which certifies that:

- You have attended a high school in which the medium of instruction is English. In this case, the school must issue a certificate stating, "The medium of instruction is English".
- You attend a University in which the medium of instruction is English. In this case, as well the University must issue a certificate stating, "The medium of instruction is English".

**We do not accept documentation issued by Universities, professors or language centers regarding the level of English knowledge. Students are required to provide all necessary documents.
