



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

The International Educational Programmes Office/Erasmus+ invites students to apply for Erasmus+ mobility for studies for the academic year 2026/2027.

Eligible students may undertake a traineeship at enterprises, research centers, ubiversities, laboratories, or other relevant organisations in Europe participating in the Erasmus+ programme.

Application Deadline: 13/01/2026 to 13/02/2026 (by 13:00 Greek time)

Eligible Mobility Period: 01/06/2026 - 31/7/2027

After completing all required fields online, applicants must also upload the following supporting documents:

- TRAINEESHIP Application form
- Official Transcript of Records from the Secretariat of their Department (PhD candidates must submit a certificate of enrollment)
- Short CV including a brief statement of motivation for participating in the ERASMUS+ programme (the CV must not be handwritten)
- Copies of language proficiency certificates
- *Letter of Acceptance from the host organization. The letter must be signed and stamped by the responsible person at the Training Organization/Institution/University.

↑ IMPORTANT:

- Students are allowed to submit only one application for participation in the Erasmus+
 Programme per academic year.
- Late or incomplete applications, as well as applications that do not include an official
 Letter of Acceptance from a host organization meeting the requirements stated on
 our website, will not be accepted and will not be considered in the evaluation
 process.

- 2. The details of the person who will supervise the student during the internship (name, position, telephone number, email, etc.),
- 3. The exact traineeship period (start and end dates),
- 4. A brief description of the trainee's duties and responsibilities & a clear statement that the internship is accepted as part of the **Erasmus+ Traineeship** programme.
