

## **SPRING SEMESTER 2022 - USEFUL INFORMATION FOR THE STUDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALY**

### **Erasmus+ Scholarship from the International Relations Office of the University of Thessaly:**

700 euros per month that is 700 euros x 4 months = 2,800 euros and 1,500 euros for travel expenses. Total= 4,300 euros.

### **Projected Billable Costs**

Room/Board: \$8,380

The student can receive a **scholarship** from the Institute for International Liberal Education that will cover the 25% of Room/Board: \$2,095 (automatically credited to student's account)

Campus Health Service Fee: \$235

Security Deposit (refundable): \$225

Health Insurance options (full coverage details sent to student upon acceptance):

(1) Bard Student Health Insurance: \$1,521

(2) ISO Care Insurance: \$510

TOTAL (1): \$8,226

TOTAL (2): \$7,255

The student can work at the EH Media Corps and receive \$12.50/ hour (5-8 hours a week).

### **Additional costs to the student would include:**

SEVIS and J-1 visa fees

Air travel to/from JFK airport in NYC

Personal expenses
